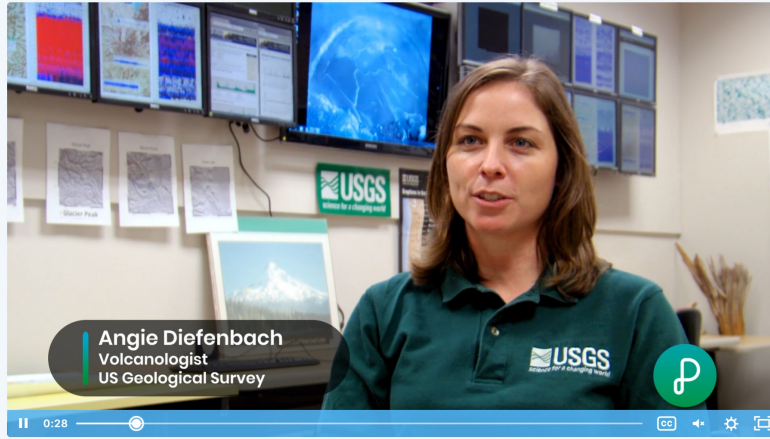
2. Locate and select the desired career.
