The **Skills Survey** is the O*Net Ability Profiler, a series of tests designed to match your abilities with potential careers.

The Skills survey results provide useful information that helps you identify your strengths. The results also help you identify training needs and occupations you may wish to explore further.

You must be 16 years old to complete this test accurately. It is recommended that you not take this test more than once every 6 months.

The total time needed to complete the O*Net Ability Profiler is 53 minutes.

There are 6 sections in the O*Net Ability Profiler, and each has its own time limit:

Section	Duration
Arithmetic Reasoning	20 minutes
Vocabulary	8 minutes
Three-Dimensional Space	8 minutes
Computation	6 minutes
Name Comparison	6 minutes
Object Matching	5 minutes

Each section has its own instructions. It is important to read all of the instructions carefully.

The instructions will also help you decide how fast you should work and when it is best to guess.

To complete the Skills Survey:

1. From the **My Tracker** menu, select **Assessment progress**.
