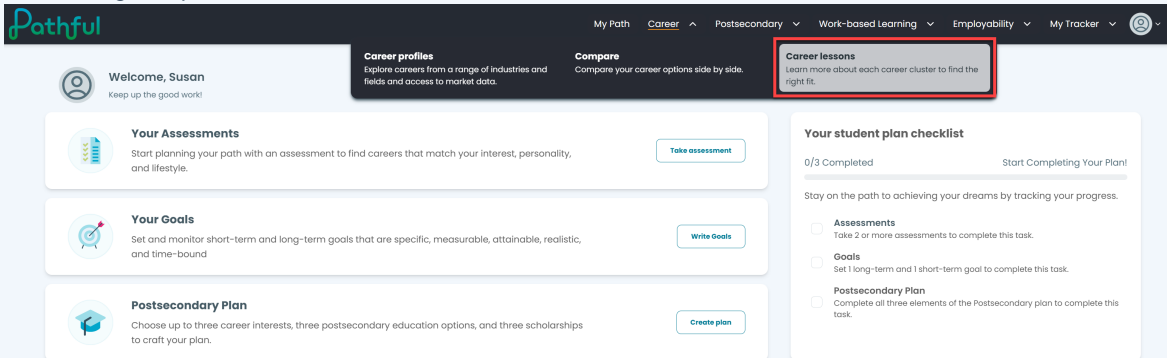


Self-assign a Lesson

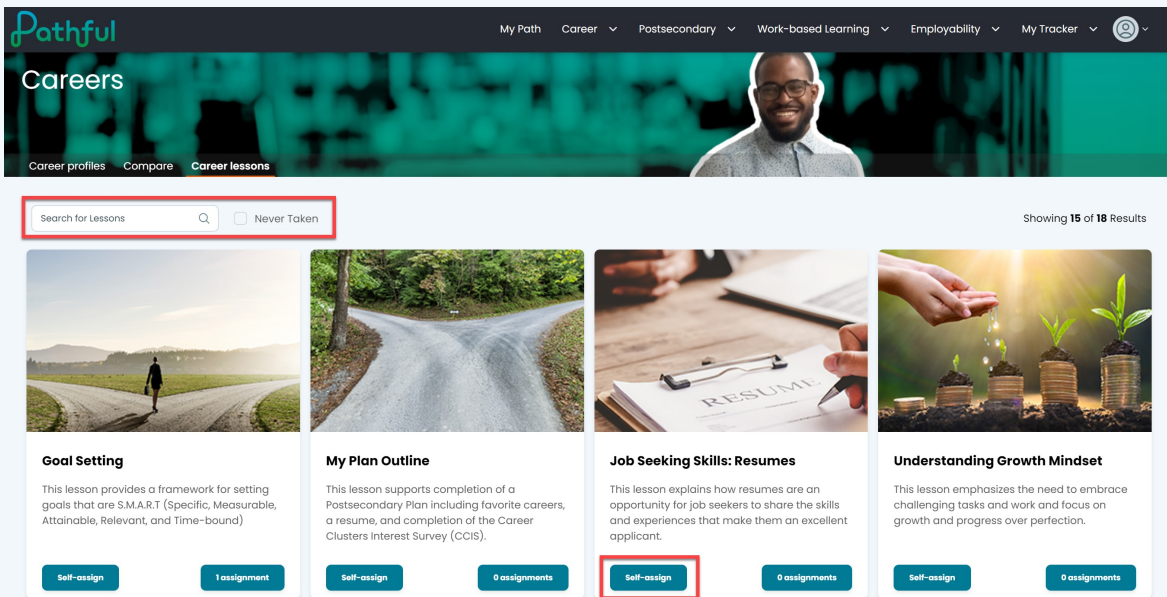
Learners can self-assign Lessons in the following areas: **Careers, Postsecondary, Work-based Learning, and Employability.**

1. From any drop-down menu, select **Lessons**.
