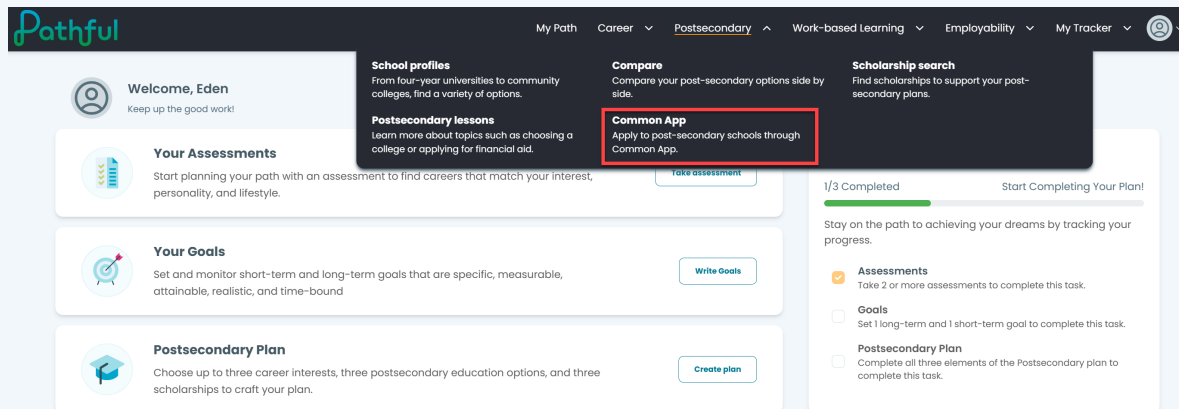


Connect to Common App as a Student

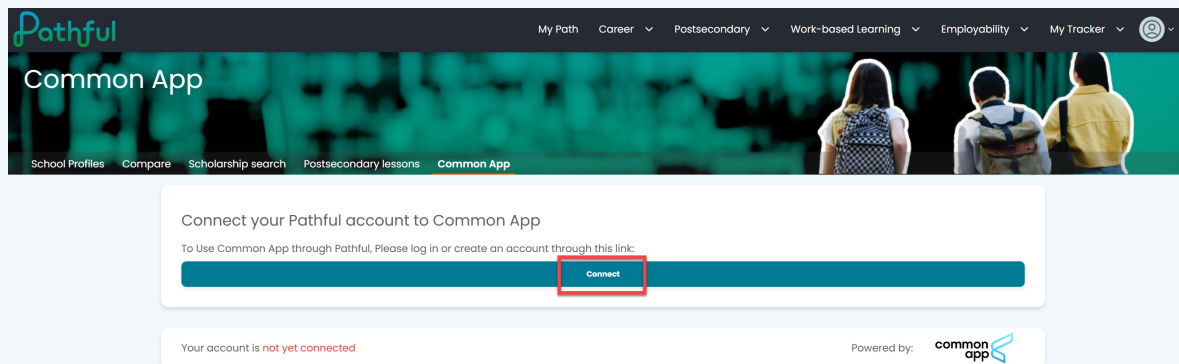

1. From the **Postsecondary** menu, select **Common App**.
